



LAST DAY OF SCHOOL — IMPORTANT!!

In early April we sent out communications notifying the community of our revised final day of school, with the disclaimer “there is a small chance that legislative action will provide additional relief, in which the calendar will again change.”

Change is happening: Governor Whitmer is expected to sign a bill that allows us to waive any days that were canceled due to the State of Emergency declared on January 29-31, & February 1, 2019. We now have an additional 4 days of school that will be forgiven (pending Gov. Whitmer’s signature).

Our final day of school is once again Friday, June 7th. In order for this to be our final day, we need to **add a half-day of school on Friday, May 24th.** Additionally, we need to add 8 minutes to the school day - the school day will begin 4 minutes earlier and end 4 minutes later effective **Monday, May 6, 2019.**
